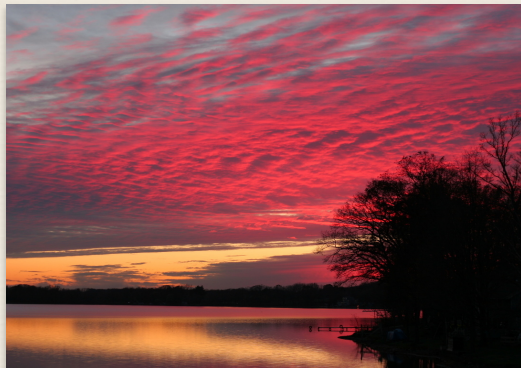

## DID YOU KNOW?

- Wall Lake was formed 10,000 years ago when glaciers, 1-2 miles thick, moved through the Upper Midwest.
- Wall Lake gets most of its water from a 1,000 acre acid bog south of the wetlands.
- The southern wetlands filter the acidic bog water entering Wall Lake, making it safe for living organisms.
- If the wetlands are harmed and acidic bog water flows freely into Wall Lake, all plant and animal life in the lake will die.
- Wall Lake's renewal rate (how long it takes for the water in a lake to replace itself) is 3 years. This is a very slow renewal rate. Most lakes renew their water in less than 3 months. Wall Lake has a slow renewal rate because water enters and leaves our lake very slowly.
- Wall Lake has excellent water quality because of our wetlands.

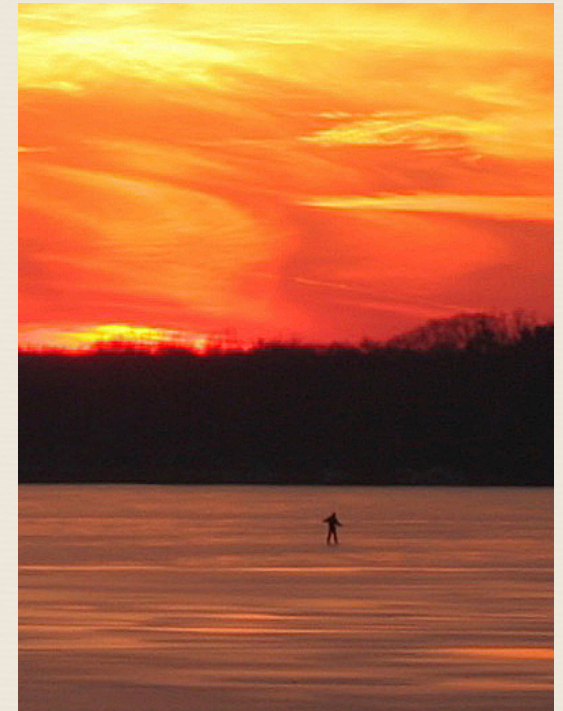

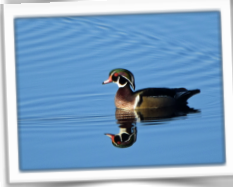
